SQA Exams

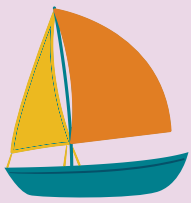
Please be aware that due to Friday 23rd May being an in-service day and Monday 26th May being a school holiday, the school canteen will not be open.

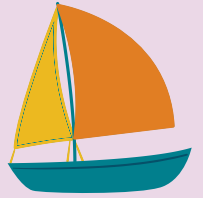

Kintyre Seaports



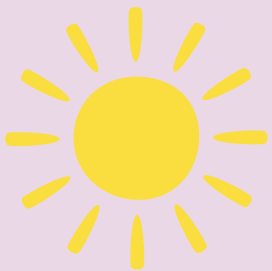
