










University of West of Scotland Visit

Remember all 5-22 year old are entitiled to free bus travel in Scotland

Turning 12? It's time for a new NEC with a photo!

Children need a new National Entitlement Card (NEC) with a photo on it from their 12th birthday to keep using free bus travel. Cards without a photo are only valid until the day before your child's 12th birthday. You can apply from their 11th birthday - and you can choose a Young Scot card for extra discounts and rewards.

This card gives your child continued access to free bus travel — helping them get to school, meet friends, and explore their world. Find out how to apply and read tips for parents, guardians and carers at freebus.scot
