When a pupils does not register for a class throughout the rest of the day we will send a text to alert you, the message reads:


'Pupil name is not in class. We are currently trying to locate them. If you are aware of a reason for this, please contact the school.'

The school office is open daily between 8am and 4pm














## Keep informed!
