# Young Scot NEC card and Free Bus travel

**Remember all 5-22 year old are entitled to free bus travel in Scotland**

**Turning 12? It's time for a new NEC with a photo!**

**Children need a new National Entitlement Card (NEC) with a photo on it from their 12th birthday to keep using free bus travel. Cards without a photo are only valid until the day before your child's 12th birthday. You can apply from their 11th birthday**

**- and you can choose a Young Scot card for extra discounts and rewards.**

**This card gives your child continued access to free bus travel — helping them get to school, meet friends, and explore their world. Find out how to apply and read tips for parents, guardians and carers at [freebus.scot](https://freebus.scot)**
