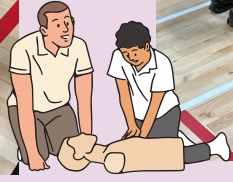

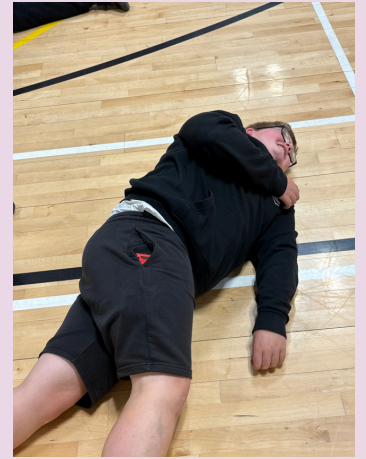

We will be collecting all Chromebooks and Locker Keys from pupils during the month of June. We will share the specific collection dates closer to the time.

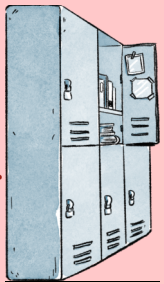


Chromebooks

- Maintenance: All devices will be checked and updated over the summer.
- Reissue: Chromebooks will be returned to pupils in August.

Lockers and Keys

- Clearance: Pupils must empty their lockers completely before returning their keys.
- Deposits: The £5 deposit will be refunded upon the return of the key.
- Lost Keys: If a key has been lost, pupils must inform the staff member at the collection point.
- New Term: Pupils may purchase a locker for the new session in August; please note this may not be available until the second week of term.



iPayimpact Balances for School Leavers

- If the account has a positive balance: Please contact the school office to request one of the following options:

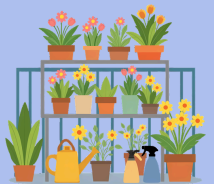

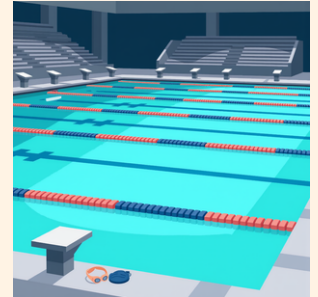
