The S1/S2 girls football team travelled to Toryglen Football Centre for the SPAR Girls Future Stars National Finals where eighteen teams from across Scotland were divided into three groups.

Competing in the five morning fixtures, the girls recorded three wins, one draw and one defeat. They produced some excellent football throughout, including impressive individual and team goals, alongside a standout penalty save from Taylor Black.

Their strong performance saw them finish top of their group, securing a place in the SPAR Cup at Hampden Park. Against high-quality opposition, the team showed resilience, determination and a clear enjoyment of the occasion, playing with confidence and positivity throughout.

Finishing among the top six school teams in the country is a fantastic achievement. The girls are a credit to their families, coaches and school, they should be incredibly proud of their success!

SCOTTISH SCHOOLS NATIONAL SWIMMING

Well done to our CGS swimmers who travelled to Aberdeen for the Scottish Schools National Finals after qualifying in the regional heats in February. They were outstanding ambassadors for CGS and this was particularly evident in the team championships, where they worked collaboratively with swimmers from other schools to achieve a shared goal. In the Scottish Schools Team Championships, Kyle McQuaker (S2), Niamh McSporran (S2), Hannah Millar (S6) & Niamh Quinn (S6) formed a CGS freestyle and medley relay team and both Kyle & Hannah represented Argyll & Bute as part of a team of four in both freestyle and medley relays along with swimmers from Hermitage Academy and Lomond School. In the individual finals the following day, in session one Hannah Millar competed in the 200m Individual Medley where she finished in 8th place in a time of 2:51.41. Session two saw Kyle McQuaker finish in 7th place overall in the 200m backstroke in a new long course PB of 2:31.88 and Niamh Quinn finished 11th in the 100m breaststroke in 1:25.29. In session three of the finals Kyle McQuaker swam a strong 100m backstroke to finish in 6th place overall in 1:10.83 and Niamh Quinn rounded off all the swims from CGS swimmers with the 200m breaststroke where she swam 3:08.78 to finish 7th overall. Fantastic swimming from all CGS swimmers and a special mention to our Castlehill Primary School mixed medley relay team who finished in 2nd place in the Scottish Schools Team Championships.
